JOURNALISTS HONORED WITH REGIONAL GREAT PLAINS JOURNALISM AWARDS

The Tulsa Press Club honored a record number of newspapers, websites, radio and tv stations on Friday, May 5, during its 14th annual Great Plains Journalism Awards.

The Omaha World-Herald Staff took home Great Plains Best Newspaper of the Year honors and Tulsa World Magazine was named Great Plains Magazine of the Year. Best Website was awarded to the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette.

Student and professional journalists from eight states — Oklahoma, Kansas, Nebraska, South Dakota, North Dakota, Iowa, Arkansas and Missouri — are eligible for the contest. Entries were judged by award-winning professional journalists from across the country.
